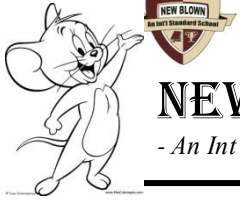

Meaning: I declare the holiness and purity of my Lord, the Greatest.

Ans: The Tasbih of Sijdah is:

“Subhana Rabbiyal Aa’la.”

Meaning: I declare the holiness and purity of my Lord, the Highest.

c) How many waqt of salat are there?

Ans: There are five waqt of salat. They are –a) Fajr, b) Zuhr, c) Asr, d) Maghrib and e) Isha.

d) How many Farzes are there in Wadu?

Ans: There are four important steps in Wadu. These are known as Fard of Wadu.

e) How many pillars are there in Islam?

Ans: There are five pillars of Islam. They are:

- a) Iman,
- b) Salat,
- c) Zakat,
- d) Saum and
- e) Hajj.

f) Why wadu is good for our eyes?

Ans: The greatest gift of Allah is our two eyes. If we do wadu regularly, our eyes will remain clean.

g) Write down salam with the meaning?

Ans: “Assalamualaikum wa rahmatullah.”

h) What does “Sagirah Gunah” mean?

Ans: “Sagira Gunah” means minor sins, Sagirah Gunah is forgiven through wadu.

2. Competency based questions:

a. What is Ibadat? Write with example.

Ans: Ibadat means to do slavery, to do Amal and to do work. To do the work according to the commands of Allah and Rasul (Sm) is called Ibadat. For example- we talk to the people. We do not tell a lie at the time of talking. Because; Allah Ta’ala has forbidden to tell a lie. Main Ibadats are four.

They are- Salat, Zakat, Saum and Hajj.

b. What is the benefit of cleanliness and purity?

Ans: We need to keep our body and clothes clean and pure. A person does not feel good if his body and clothes are not clean and pure. It is mentioned in the Qur'an Majid, "Surely Allah loves those who are repentant and who remain clean and pure." A man who is not clean and pure suffers from various diseases. Allah loves those who remain clean and pure. We shall keep ourselves clean and pure.

c. How many Fardes of Wadu are there? What are they?

Ans: There are four important steps in Wadu. These are known as Fard of Wadu. These are:

- i) To wash the whole face once.
- ii) To wash both the hands and arms up to elbow once.
- iii) To rub one fourth of the head once.
- iv) To wash the feet up to ankle once.

d) Write the rules of Sijdah.

Ans: We shall go to Sijdah by saying Allahu Akber. Both of our knees will be on the praying mat. Then we shall put our hands apart on the mat. We shall touch the mat with our forehead and nose in between the spread hands. Tasbih is to be said in Sijdah. The Tasbih of Sijdah is- 'Subhana Rabbial Aa'la'

Meaning: I declare the holiness and purity of my Lord, the Highest.

e) What is the moral benefit of Salat?

Ans: We shall perform Salat with Iman. If we perform Salat like this, fear is made in the heart of man. With this fear men can refrain from the evil deeds. Then those are rich among us can understand the sorrows and sufferings of the poor. Poor and needy people can say their sorrows and sufferings to the rich. The rich will come forward to help them. In this way a peaceful environment will be made.
